Achieving the LEED AP credential legally allows you to manage the LEED certification process for new buildings.

The LEED AP Building Design + Construction Exam Credential demonstrates knowledge of green design, construction and operations. A LEED credential shows that you have the necessary knowledge, experience and credibility to make any LEED project or sustainability-focused organization successful.
